Level 1 - Church Preparation: Introduction to Crisis and Disaster Response, A Day of Training.

- Cost \$25.00 per person.
- Required for all who wish to assist their church in helping church members.

Recommended:

- CERT Training – usually free and taught by local fire department.
- IS 100b – Introduction to the Incident Command System.

Level 2 – Church Community Teams:

- Complete Level 1.
- Complete NCN Participation Agreement and Volunteers Working With Minors.
- Complete IS 100b – Introduction to the Incident Command System.

Recommended:

- IS 700a – National Incident Management System, An Introduction.
- CERT Training – usually free and taught by local fire department.

Level 3 - Specialized Volunteers:

- Complete Levels 1 & 2
- IS 700a – National Incident Management System, An Introduction.
- Specialized Training in your area of service, i.e. food service, chaplaincy, construction, providing shelter services.

Recommended:

- CERT Training.
- IS 800b – National Response Framework, An Introduction.

Level 4 - Site Leadership:

- Complete Levels 1, 2 & 3.
- IS 800b – National Response Framework, An Introduction.
- Specialized Training based on your role as a site leader – i.e. Shelter Management; Food Service Management, etc.

Recommended:

- CERT Training.
- IS 230d – Fundamentals of Emergency Management.

Level 5 – District Leadership Team:

- Complete Levels 1, 2, 3 & 4.
- IS 230d – Fundamentals of Emergency Management.
- Skills and Education as a leader/manager in your area of expertise – Chaplaincy, Facilities Management, Insurance Agent, Safety Inspection, Contractors, etc.

Recommended:

- CERT Training.
- Complete the National Emergency Management Executive Academy.
